





- Chambery: 123 km




A40 Motorway to Cluses (Exit n°17) Follow Taninges (10km) Follow signs for Les Gets

COMPETITION RULES

The competitions will be held according to the valid UCI Rules in their current version.

LIABILITY / INSURANCE

The organizer shall not be held liable for any damages caused to persons or material / equipment. All participants must be covered by sufficient health, accident and liability insurance. By submitting theentry form the respected Team / National Federation confirms that all persons registered are covered by the appropriate insurance (in accordance with UCI Competition Rules).

MEDICAL

A dedicated medical team will be available during all official practice and competition. The team consists of doctors, nurses and first aid personnel. The dedicated medical center is located very close to both finish areas and rescue teams will be strategically placed on course during the races.

PHARMACY

The Pharmacy is located in the centre of Les Gets, in front of the Tourist Office.

ANTIDOPING CONTROL

Swab will be performed in accordance with the UCI regulations.

In the same building as Media Center for DHI

- In a building located close to the XCO finish area for XCO

Riders identified for testing will be collected by their chaperone from the venue pick up point and then taken directly to the testing facilities (50 metres by foot).

PRIZE MONEY

The athletes or Team Managers concerned by Prize Money must come to the Tourist Office front desk from 30 minutes before and 1h30 hour after the prize giving ceremonies and ask for Nathalie Tellier.

The Prize Money will be given in cash until 1000 € and paid by bank transfers for amounts higher than 1000 €. Please note that according to the French Law, there is a withdrawal of 15% tax deducted at source for all foreigners.





TEAM AREAS

Teams will be allocated according to their size, and to their UCI ranking. Teams are allowed to set up their stand from Monday 28th to Wednesday 30th. Very few non-UCI teams will be allowed to set up their areas on Thursday 01st. According to the UCI regulations, all Elite MTB Teams must remain in place until the end of the last event on Sunday 04th of

All the signs must be correctly fixed, weighed down or pegged to avoid any accident in case of heavy wind.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The area booked is the maximum space that can be used (size of the stand including team cars that are intended to be parked in the team zone !!). All stands will be marked and measured by the organisers. Exhibitors must check in with the organisers upon arrival at the Event Village. The organisers will direct exhibitors to the relevant stand location.

FLOWER CEREMONIES

The competitors ranked one through three in the men and women Elite XCO / XCC and men and women Elite DHI competitions are requested to present themselves for the flower ceremony close to the finish area immediately after the end of the competition.

AWARD CEREMONIES

Award ceremonies will take place on the main stage located in the XCO finish area (between ski school and Bellevue Hotel), according to the schedule in the program. A space dedicated to the athletes preparing for the award ceremonies will be setup behind the stage. Water and towels will be provided for athletes. Due to limited space, only one support staff member will be permitted into this area to assist in preparing the athlete for award ceremonies.

WASTE MANAGEMENT

General waste and recycling bins are located throughout the venue. Please ensure that your team space is kept free of rubbish. For larger items please use the permanent grey bins which are located all around the village.

ELECTRICITY

Please bring your own extension cable minimum 30m long.

BIKE WASH

2 dedicated bike wash station will be available on site. Teams who asked to get their own bike wash area will get private access where they will be able to plug their own high pressure washer

(Please bring your own hosepipe, minimum 50m long).

SECURITY

A security firm will be on site every day from the end of the races to the start of the competitions the day





GENERAL PROVISIONS

- A recent (within 48hrs) negative test result (PCR test, vaccinated twice or recovered) is mandatory for riders, national federation & UCI-Team staff, accredited media, UCI staff including commissaires, anti-doping, timing, announcer, and implementation.
- A negative test or a certificate of vaccination or a proof of recovery must be shown to be able to pick up an accreditation on spot
- If a negative test is required to enter France, depending on the country you are travelling from. All information about travelling and restrictions: https://www.diplomatie.gouv.fr/en/coming-to-france/
- There will also be a testing and result service available at the venue for anyone who needs one to travel on to another event, or on to another country where a negative test result is required to enter Les Gets Medical Center

- A contact tracing form including accreditation request must be completed and returned by everybody attending the event.

- Face masks/face coverings are required be worn at all times at the event venue, with the exception of riders on course (training and race). Any person at the event venue who is seen to be without a mask for an extended period of time will have their accreditation removed.
- Regular hand washing/sanitizing is expected. Hand sanitizer will be provided at multiple locations on the event area.
- Social distancing of minimum 1.5m is expected at all times.

BUBBLES

- Bubbles are a group who can mix together but who cannot mix with another bubble. They are identified as follows:
- o Team for the purpose of this document all athletes, National Federation and registered UCI-Team staff who are accredited to the event are referred to as "Team"
- We recommend each team forms their own bubble. o Media
- oLOC will also separate into smaller functional bubbles. o UCI will also separate into smaller functional bubbles.
- o TV will also separate into smaller functional bubbles.
- Bubbles must keep separated wherever possible and any interaction must respect distancing and use of masks.
- The priority at all times is given to the team bubble.

ACCREDITATION CENTRE

- There are separate entrances for teams and others.
- An accreditation is delivered only:
- o On receipt of the contact tracing form.
- o On proof of a negative COVID-19 test result (PCR test, vaccinated twice or recovered) within the previous 48hrs.

RIDERS' CONFIRMATION

- Distance lines shall be painted on the floor with a limited number of people in the room at the same time. Please respect distance and numbers in the room.
- Only one person per nation/team is allowed.
- Separate entry and exit will be available.

TEAM MANAGERS MEETING

 No team managers' meeting will be held. All information will be distributed by communique.

TEAM AREA

- Only riders and team staff are allowed in the team area.
- No media are allowed in the team area.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FEDERATIONS & TEAMS

- Create and adhere to your own team bubble.
 Minimise contact with other bubbles wherever possible.
- With the exception of your team videographers who are in your team bubble, other media are not allowed in the team area and all media requests you receive and any casual contact with media should be managed appropriately.

• Consider any technical service-providers in Tech Alley as a separate bubble and manage any contact appropriately.

o Expect to be asked for contact

tracing information by service-providers and provide this accurately.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ATHLETES

- Avoid signing autographs and taking selfies with fans.
- Wear a mask unless on the course/track
- XCO riders, continue to wear a mask until 2 minutes to start.
- Only agree to a media interview if the interviewer is distancing & taking appropriate hygiene measures.

CROSS-COUNTRY

- Call up boxes
- o Media are not allowed in call up boxes.
- o Commissaires will remain at entrance of the boxes wherever possible.
- o Technical Commissaires will do their checks outside of the boxes where possible.
- o Top 8 box only rider & team staff allowed, no media or television will be present.

Start

o A reduced number of media will be allowed. o Team staff should stay in the B-zone areas set up before the start arch to collect clothing, bottles etc.

Feed and Technical Assistance Area

- o Only team staff with a feed zone pass can enter the area.
- o Masks/face covering must be worn at all times. o Commissaires shall keep their distance from the teams where possible.
- o Shimano shall keep their distance from the teams where possible.

Finish

- o A reduced number of media will be allowed. o Only 1 TV cameraman will be present.
- o A minimum number of key UCI/LOC staff will be present.
- o All riders will pass through a mixed-zone after the Finish, media will respect distancing & interview protocols.

Riders will be able to access a member of team staff to collect a face mask, bottle, clothing etc.




DOWNHILL

- A maximum of 3 people will be allowed in a gondola.
- There will be separate entrances for riders/teams & others.
- No mixing between bubbles in a gondola.
- Where possible bikes shall be handled by the rider/team staff only.
- No media will be allowed in the start area.
- Only the current leader will be on the hot seat.
- All riders will pass through the mixed-zone after exiting the Finish bowl.
- B-zone: it is the responsibility of each individual to respect distance in the B-zone as there will be a mix between Team and Media bubbles.

PODIUM

- Distance between the podium steps should be respected.
- Only key UCI/LOC staff, 1 cameraman, the UCI speaker will be allowed behind the podium
- Riders will pick up trophies themselves behind the podium before the ceremony starts.





Starting from Monday 28th 9:00a.m. In view of the various health restrictions, we recommend that managers collect the accreditations for their entire team. Accreditations will only be given to people who have filled in the google form beforehand.

The Accreditation Office is located inside La Colombière area.
